



'Many individuals who earn moderate incomes, better known as the 'sandwiched' class, may not qualify for legal aid and consequently may not receive the legal help they need. An ageing population, coupled with greater economic and political volatility, will accentuate this. It is necessary to understand where these trends may lead us and be prepared for the possible future impact. There will be increased demands on resources available for legal services including the provision of public legal assistance for the needy.

Aristotle's famous maxim "The whole is greater than the sum of its parts" aptly describes the CJC's successful approach in forging meaningful collaborations with various partners to achieve its principal objective of enhancing access to justice for LiPs. In its fifth year of operations, the CJC continues to assist a growing number of litigants by providing advice and information on a range of matters. It continues to look for new ways to collaborate with law firms and the law schools to make the legal process more comprehensible for LiPs so that they can understand their legal issues better and consequently, be better prepared for their cases in court. In line with this, the CJC recently established a satellite office at the Supreme Court. The CJC has also collaborated with the local law schools to produce a simplified infographic chart for the litigants it serves to help them better understand the legal issues they may face'. - Excerpt from the Chief Justice's Message, CJC's AR 2017
